BYLAW NO. 14024

A BYLAW to amend the Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BYLAW 1961, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2019.
- 2. Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961, as amended, is further amended by:
 - (a) adding the following after Section 13. (10):
 - "(11) No person shall operate, park or stop a vehicle on a street unless proof of valid insurance permitting operation of the vehicle on a highway is clearly displayed on that vehicle."
 - (b) repealing subsection 35. (1) in its entirety replacing it with the following:
 - "(1) Without limiting the foregoing, all police officers and bylaw enforcement officers are hereby authorized and empowered to remove, detain, or impound any vehicle, chattel or obstruction unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or public place, and to recover all costs and expenses incurred thereby either from the owner of the chattel, or by the sale of the chattel at public auction, or by action in any court of competent jurisdiction."
