# A BYLAW respecting recreation facility rentals and admissions

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY RECREATION FEES AND ADMISSIONS BYLAW 2019.
- 2. Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission may charge for use of, or admission to, sports and recreation facilities the fees specified in Schedule "A".
- 3. Burnaby Recreation Fees and Admissions Bylaw 2018, Bylaw No. 13889, is repealed effective the first day of September, 2019.
- 4. Where applicable, Goods and Services Tax (GST) and/or Provincial Sales Tax (PST) will be added to the fees specified in Schedule "A".
- 5. This Bylaw comes into force on the first day of September, 2019.

#### XVII. PROGRAM FEES

Program fees are based upon instructional staff costs, supply costs, plus a percentage of recovery of facility costs. Programs are cancelled if attendance is insufficient to recover the costs of the program. The variety of programs offered depends upon public demand and requests for service.

#### XVIII. RECREATION CREDIT PROGRAM

Recreation credit for Burnaby residents in financial need as determined by a recognized outside agency.

Credit per person, per year	\$196.00

#### XIX. FOOD SERVICES

Prices for food products and services are established according to industry practice and market acceptance.

#### XX. COMPLIMENTARY PASSES (Effective 2020 January 01- December 31)

Issued to Freemen, current Mayor and Councillors and current Parks, Recreation & Culture Commissioners. Passes provide access to arenas, pools, golf courses, indoor courts, weight rooms and the Burnaby Village Museum up to a maximum of \$1,500.00 per person per year.

#### XXI. FEE WAIVERS (Effective 2020 January 01- December 31)

Fee waivers are occasionally granted for special events such as the Burnaby Charity Golf Classic, Jack Crosby Novice All Star Tournament, etc.

Annual maximum value of use	\$75,000.00

#### XXII. COURTESY PASSES & PROMOTIONS (Effective 2020 January 01- December 31)

Used for promotional activities, public relations initiatives or to reimburse for disruption in services. (Note: Does not include golf services and Burnaby Village Museum)
