CITY OF BURNABY BYLAW NO. 14289

A BYLAW to amend the Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BYLAW
 1961, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2021.
- 2. Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961, as amended, is further amended by adding the following after subsection 6(2):
 - "(3) A person driving a vehicle on a school day and on a highway where signs are displayed stating a speed limit of 30 km/h, or on which a school area warning is shown with a 30 km/h speed limit, must drive at a rate of speed not exceeding 30 km/h while approaching or passing the school building and school grounds to which the signs relate, between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. on a school day."
