#### Abstract

A BY-LuAF to authorize the expenaiture of $\$ 30,000.00$ out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 504.0 of the Municipal Act for the purpose of Widening of Kingsway thoroughfare within the Municipality.


WHEREAS the Corporation has by By-law 1951 authorized the setting aside of all monies derived from the sale of Tax \$ale Lands, and the said monies have been deposited in a special account in the Royal Bank of Canada at Mew Westminster, B.C.

AND WHEREAS the amount standing to the oredit of the said special account as at the Phirtieth day of September, 1948 amounts to $\$ 38,603.00$

AIN WhBeras the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable that the sum of $\$ 30,000.00$ should be used for the purpose of Widening of Kingsway thoroughfare within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of said Section 504.0 paragraph (1) it is provided that the money and any interest thereon so set aside under the provisions of the Section shall not be used for any purpose except:
(a) For bringing the sinking funds up to requirements Where the sinking funds on hand are less than requirements.
(b) For the reduction of debenture debt, bank loans, or demand loans, and
(c) For expenditure of a capital or other special nature

AND WHEFEAS the requirements for Sinking Fund purposes
are up to requirements,
AND WHEREAS there are no demand notes or bank loans
outstanaing,
THEREFONE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-
(1) the sum of $\$ 30,000.00$ being part of monies set aside under the provisions of Section 504.0 by Bylaw 1951, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of Widening of Kingsway thoroughfare within the Municipality.
(2) The Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation are hereby empowered to do all necessary acts and things to give effect to transfer and use of funds hereby authorized.
(3) This By-law shall come into force and effect upon receiving approval of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.
(4) This By-law may be cited as "BURIVABY TAX SALE LANDS MONIES EXPENDIYURE BY-LAW MO. 14, 1948".
