BY-LAW NO. 2041

A BY-LAW to authorize the expenditure of \$14,846.00 out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 504.C of the "Municipal Act" to provide for an additional amount required for the completion of a new school building being constructed on Parts of Blocks 25 and 26, D.L. 30, Group 1, New Westminster District.

WHEREAS The Corporation has by By-law 1951 authorized the setting aside of all monies derived from the sale of Tax Sale lands, and the said monies have been deposited in a special account in the Royal Bank of Canada at New Westminster, B.C.

AND WHEREAS the amount standing to the credit of the said special account as at the Fifteenth (15th) day of October 1948, amounts to \$28,566.00

AND WHEREAS the Board of School Trustees of The District of Burnaby, on the 4th day of October 1948, requested the Council to set a date to receive an Extra-Ordinary Estimate.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby on the 4th day of October 1948 by resolution, set the Eighteenth day of October, 1948 as the date on which to receive the said Extra-Ordinary Estimate.

AND WHEREAS on the said Eighteenth day of October 1948, the Board of School Trustees submitted an Extra-Ordinary Estimate as follows:-

CLASS "E" - Other extra-ordinary requirements

Additional sum of money required to complete the new Junior High School now under construction on the present Edmonds Street School site, owing to the fact that the actual tenders received exceeded the amount of money on hand \$29,692.00

Less: Government Assistance
50%

Net Total Estimates CLASS "E"
\$14,846.00

AND WHEREAS on the said Eighteenth day of October 1948, the Extra-Ordinary Estimate as submitted was approved by the Municipal Council.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the monies required for this expenditure shall be provided from the monies standing to the credit of the said special account.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of said Section 504.C Paragraph (1) it is provided that the money and any interest thereon so set aside under the provisions of the Section shall not be used for any purpose except:

- (a) For bringing the sinking funds up to requirements where the sinking funds on hand are less than requirements.
- (b) For the reduction of debenture debt, bank loans, or demand loans, and
- (c) For expenditure of a capital or other special nature.

AND WHEREAS the requirements for Sinking Fund purposes are up to requirements.

AND WHEREAS there are no demand notes or bank loans outstanding.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- The sum of \$14,846.00 being part of monies set aside under the provisions of Section 504.C of the Municipal Act by Bylaw No. 1951 of this Corporation, is hereby appropriated to provide for an additional amount required for the completion of a new school building being constructed on Parts of Blocks 25 and 26, D.L. 30, Group 1, New Westminster District.
- That the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation are hereby empowered to do all necessary acts and things to give effect to transfer and use of funds hereby authorized.
- This By-law shall come into force and effect upon receiving the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.
- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX SALE LANDS MONIES EXPENDITURE BY-LAW NO. 15, 1948."
