

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 2042.

A BY-LAW for the abandonment of certain properties
taken for the widening of Kingsway

WHEREAS under By-law No. 1956 The Corporation took or expropriated for Municipal purposes certain lands for carrying out the widening of Kingsway as in the said By-law provided, a portion of which is unnecessary for such purpose.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to subsection 1 of Section 372 of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, and of all other powers them hereunto enabling, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands and premises as shown on the sketch plan annexed hereto being unnecessary for the carrying out of the widening of Kingsway for which purpose the said lands were taken, are not required and are abandoned by the Municipality.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "KINGSWAY (BURNABY) EXPROPRIATION ABANDONING BY-LAW NO.2. 1948"
