

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 2074

A BY-LAW to specially assess those parcels of lands within District Lot Eighty (80) Group 1, New Westminster District, for the amounts charged against them under the provisions of the "Special Surveys Act".

WHEREAS by an order issued by the Attorney General of the Province of British Columbia, dated the 17th day of July, 1945, Mr. G. K. Burnett, was appointed to make a special survey of portions of District Lot 80, Group 1, New Westminster District, covered by Plans 1016 and 1286.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to such order a special survey has been completed.

AND WHEREAS by Order in Council No. 351 approved on the 23rd day of February, 1948, it was ordered that the Registrar's report be adopted and confirmed, that the Surveyor's report be adopted and confirmed, and that the costs and expenses of the special survey, including all costs of publication of notices and the Order-in-Council, and Land Registry fees, with respect to parcels comprised within the limits of the survey, other than highways, shall be charged against the respective owners of the parcels in proportion to the respective area of the parcels, and with respect to parcels consisting of highways, shall be charged against The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

AND WHEREAS the said costs amount to \$1,057.53 of which the sum of \$850.92 is to be borne by the respective owners of the parcels of land comprised within the limits of the survey, and \$178.61 is to be borne by the Corporation.

AND WHEREAS Section 37 of the "Special Survey Act" R.S.B.C. 1948. Chapter 322. provides that the Council of

a Municipality in which a special survey has been made shall by by-law specially assess those parcels for the amounts so charged against them respectively;

AND WHEREAS the Council deem it advisable that the said amounts be paid in one payment.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, enacts as follows:-

1. The parcels of lands and premises as more particularly described in the schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law shall be specially assessed the amounts shown opposite the said parcel in Column 2 of the said schedule.

2. That the said amounts shall be due and payable at the Municipal Hall, Burnaby, on or before the Eighteenth day of July A.D. 1949.

3. That all the provisions of every general or special Act applicable to the collection and recovery of taxes in the Municipality and the proceedings which may be taken in default of payment thereon shall apply to the special assessment and all amounts payable thereunder.

4. This By-law shall come into force upon the registration thereof.

5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "D.L.80. Special Survey Assessment By-law 1949".
