

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 2097.

A BY-LAW to dedicate and set aside for School purposes, certain lands acquired by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby through Tax Sale proceedings.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter referred to became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby at Tax sale in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest that the said lands should be dedicated and set aside for school purposes.

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia, and composed of Lots 19 to 36 inclusive, of Block 26, Lots 19 to 36 inclusive of Block 27, Lots 1 to 36 inclusive of Block 30, and Lots 1 to 36 inclusive of Block 31, all in District Lot 122, Group 1, Map No. 1308, AND ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster, and Province of British Columbia, and composed of Lots 1 to 6 inclusive, and 12 to 18 inclusive, of Block 24, District Lot 117, Group 1, Map No. 1222, be and are hereby dedicated and set aside to and for the use of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby District.
2. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon registration thereof in the manner required by law.
3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SCHOOL DEDICATION BY-LAW 1949."
