

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NEW WESTMINSTER

BY-LAW NO. 2210

A By-law to enter into an Agreement with the Municipality of Burnaby with reference to garbage disposal.

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WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make provision for a more effective disposal of garbage, trade waste, etc.

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Burnaby is prepared to permit the depositing of such garbage on the garbage dump owned by the said Municipality of Burnaby on the lands and premises hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of New Westminster ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. An Agreement shall be entered into with the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the disposal of garbage, trade waste, etc., collected within the City of New Westminster on the garbage dump of the said Corporation of the District of Burnaby situate on Lots 41, 42, 43, 50 and 51, of Block 6, and Lots 19 to 28 (both inclusive), 38 to 44 (both inclusive), of Block 8, District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map 2686, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia,
2. Authority is hereby given to the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of New Westminster to sign, execute and affix the Corporate Seal to an Agreement between Corporation of the City of New Westminster and Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the purposes aforesaid.
3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY GARBAGE DUMP AGREEMENT BY-LAW, 1946".

(hereinafter called the "CITY")

OF THE OTHER PART:

WHEREAS the District has established a garbage dump on the lands and premises hereinafter set forth and has agreed to allow the City to use the same for the purpose of depositing thereon garbage, rubbish and trade waste upon the terms and conditions herein set forth.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter set forth the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. The District will allow the City to use the garbage dump of the District situate on Lots 41, 42, 43, 50 and 51, of Block 6, and Lots 19 to 28 (both inclusive), 38 to 44 (both inclusive), of Block 8, District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map 2686, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, as a garbage dump.

2. The said dump shall be under the sole control of an employee of the City who shall be provided and paid by the City, and who shall supervise and direct all dumping of garbage on the said dump.

3. The City will at its own cost provide from time to time such disinfectants and rat poisons as may be necessary for use on the said dump.

4. The District will lay a water main to the said dump for fire protection, truck washing, and other purposes incidental to the use of the said dump.

5. The City will so often as the same becomes necessary at its own cost extend the existing drainage culvert situated on the said lands and premises.

6. This Agreement shall come into force on the ^{1st} day of *October*, 1946, and shall continue in force until terminated by six months notice in writing by either party hereto.
