THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3010

A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Park purposes.

WHEREAS by Paragraph (d) of sub-section 202 of Section 58 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1948, it is provided that in every Municipality the Council may, by By-law finally passed by a three-rouths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through Tax Sale proceedings and set aside such area for Park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or other public purposes,

AND WHEREAS the lands hereinarter mentioned have become the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby by virtue of Tax Sale proceedings,

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient and in the public interest that the hereinafter mentioned lands in the Municipality of Burnaby should be so set aside,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation or the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. There is hereby defined and set apart for Park purposes all of the undermentioned lands:

Block eleven (11) of part of Block One (1) of Lot one hundred and twenty (120), Group one (1), Plan No. 9413, Municipality of Burnaby, New Westminster District, Province of British Columbia.

And All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnapy, and in the Province of British Columbia, being composed of a portion of Block One (1) of Lot one hundred and twenty (120), Group One (1), New Westminster District, according to Plan No. 3068 deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, which may be more particularly described as that portion of Block 1 having the metes and bounds hereinafter described, that is to say:-

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Block 1 and being the intersection of the south boundary of said Block 1 with the northeasterly limit of Douglas Road:

Thence following the said south boundary of Block 1 S.89⁰24 $\frac{1}{2}$ 'E. 245.06 Feet more or less to the southwest corner of Lot 25 of Block 24 of said Block 1;

Thence following the westerly boundary of said Lot 25 N.0° $57\frac{1}{2}$ 'E. 97.79 Feet to the southerly limit of Graveley Street;

Thence following the southerly limit of Graveley Street N.89° 02¹/₂ W. 92.79 Feet;

Thence following the westerly limit of Carlton Avenue N.0° 09'E. 218.75 Feet and N. 20° 10'E. 467.26 Feet more or less to the southerly limit of Kitchener Street:

Thence following the said southerly limit of Kitchener Street N.89° $02\frac{1}{2}$ 'W. 298.98 Feet more or less to lane 20 feet wide:

Thence following the easterly limit of said lane S. O. 09'W. 605.53 feet.

Thence N.89° $O2\frac{1}{2}$ 'W. 142 Feet more or less to the said northeasterly limit of Douglas Road:

Thence following the said limit of Douglas Road S.39^o OO_{2}^{1} 'E. 201.16 Feet more or less to the point of commencement, and containing 3.73 Acres more or less as shown outlined Red on Explanatory Plan No. 11627 deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, B.C.

Lots Twenty (20), Twenty one (21), Twenty two (22) and Twenty three (23), of Block Five (5) of District Lot Four (4), Group 1, Map No. 2121, Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1949."
