

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3026

A BY-LAW to further amend "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1943", being By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-


1. "Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1943" being By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby further amended by adding as paragraph "J" to paragraph 18, the following:

"J" It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any vehicle, either attended or unattended within the area or areas as set out in the Schedule annexed hereto for a longer period than one hour, which Schedule is hereby incorporated with and made part of this By-law, PROVIDED that all such areas shall be clearly defined by the placing of proper signs, either on the pavement or on the boulevard adjacent thereto.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1943 AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1949."

S C E D U L E

ONE HOUR PARKING AREA:

- (a) The south side of Hastings Street from Boundary Road to Willingdon Avenue, between the hours of nine o'clock a. m. and six o'clock p. m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays of each week, and between the hours of nine o'clock a. m. and one o'clock p. m. on Wednesday of each week, PROVIDED further that the provisions of this section shall not apply on any Statutory Holiday.
