THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 3027. A BY-LAW to authorize the expenditure of \$7,220.00 out of the special rund set aside under the provisions of Section 537 of the Municipal Act for the purpose of widening Hastings Street within the Municipality. WHEREAS The Corporation has by By-law No. 1951 authorized the setting aside of all monies derived from the sale of Tax Sale Lands, and the said monies have been deposited in a special account in the Royal Bank or Canada at New Westminster, B. C. December, 1949 amounts to \$17,372.00. AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation

AND WHEREAS the amount standing to the credit of the said special account as at the Nineteenth (19th) day of

of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable that the sum of \$7,220.00 should be used for the purpose of widening Hastings Street within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of said Section 537, Paragraph (1), it is provided that the money and any interest thereon so set aside under the provisions of the Section shall not be used for any purpose except:

- For bringing the sinking funds up to requirements (a) where the sinking funds on hand are less than requirements,
- (a) For the reduction of debenture debt, bank loans, or demand loans, and
- (c) For expenditure of a capital or other special nature. AND WHEREAS the requirements for Sinking Fund purposes are up to requirements.

AND WHEREAS there are no demand notes or bank loans out standing.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

(1) The sum of \$7,220.00 being part of monies set aside under the provisions of Section 537 by By-law No. 1951, is

hereby appropriated for the purpose of widening Hastings Street within the Municipality.

- (2) The works to be carried out by the funds hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Municipal Council.
- (3) Should any unexpended balance exist upon completion of the works hereby authorized, the Municipal Engineer shall submit a certificate to the Council showing the works performed, together with costs, and the unexpended balance shall be returned to the fund set aside by Hy-law No. 1951.
- (4) The Reeve and Clerk of The Corporation are hereby empowered to do all mecessary acts and things to give effect to transfer and use of runds hereby authorized.
- (5) This By-law shall come into force and errect upon receiving approval of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.
- (6) This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX SALE LANDS MONIES EXPENDITURE BY-LAW NO. 20, 1949."
