THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 3069.

A BY-LAW to authorise the sale of certain Tax Sale Lands belonging to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sales held by the Collector of Burnaby, the lands hereinafter described became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS Alfred Hope Clary and Nicholas Kalyk, c/o 3579 Kingsway, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, have offered to purchase the hereinafter mentioned lands for the sum of Four thousand five hundred (\$4,500.00) dollars, AND IT IS advisable to accept the said offer.

AND WHEREAS insofar as and to the extent that there are buildings erected upon the said land, such have, prior to disposal, been advertised for sale once in a newspaper circulating within the District of Burnaby in accordance with the provisions in that regard contained in the "Municipal Act".

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore ENACTS as follows:-

of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burmaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as the Westerly Five hundred and two (502) feet of Block Twenty-five (25) of Lot Sixty-eight (68) Group One (1) District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan 11556 deposited, having a frontage of 502 feet on Elmwood Street and extending with uniform width for the full depth of said Block 25 and adjoining the Westerly boundary thereof and containing 7.13 acres more or less, be sold and disposed of to Alfred Hope Clary and

Nicholas Kalyk, both of the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, Contractors, for the sum of Four thousand, five hundred (\$4,500.00) dollars.

- 2. That upon payment of the consideration herein named, conveyance to the said Alfred Hope Clary and Nicholas Kalyk be executed under the Seal of The Corporation by the Reeve and Clerk and be delivered to the said purchasers.
- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 15, 1950."
