

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3081

A BY-LAW to provide for the opening of a poll  
in advance of the regular poll, for the  
1951 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Section 22 of the Municipal Elections Act provides  
that the Council of a District Municipality may provide for the  
holding of a poll in advance of the regular poll for the Municipal  
Election.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient that the said poll  
be established.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council for The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. That an advance poll for the 1951 Municipal Election be  
opened on the Thursday, December 14th, 1950, and Friday,  
December 15th, 1950, and shall be kept open between the hour  
of 10:00 o'clock a. m. and 3 o'clock p. m. on each of the said  
days.

2. The persons who shall be permitted to vote on the first  
two days of the poll -- namely, the Thursday and Friday --  
as mentioned in Paragraph (1), shall be those only who are  
duly qualified voters and who shall sign a statement showing  
that it is their expectation that they will be absent from  
the municipality on the final day of the poll.

3. This By-law shall be cited as "BURNABY ADVANCE POLL  
BY-LAW 1950."
