

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3088

A BY-LAW to dedicate and set aside for Hospital purposes, certain lands acquired by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby through tax sale proceedings.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter referred to became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby at Tax Sale in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest that the said lands should be dedicated and set aside for use by the Burnaby Hospital Society for the purpose of erecting a Hospital thereon.

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. ALL AND SINGULAR That certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia, and composed of Lot One (1) of Block Twenty six (26) of District Lot Sixty eight (68) Group One (1) Map No. 11556. be and is hereby dedicated and set aside to and for the use of the Burnaby Hospital Society for the purpose of erecting a Hospital thereon.

2. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon registration thereof in the manner required by law.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HOSPITAL SITE DEDICATION BY-LAW 1950."
