

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3099

A BY-LAW to amend "Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1928."

WHEREAS by sub-section 9 of Section 58 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1948 it is provided that the Council may from time to time make, alter and repeal By-laws for indemnifying the Reeve and Councillors by a sum of money out of the annual revenue to each in respect of their attendance at meetings of the Council and Committees.

AND WHEREAS the said sub-section further provides that the remuneration to the Mayor or Reeve of a Municipality having a population of forty thousand or more may be at a rate not exceeding six thousand dollars per annum, and that the remuneration to Aldermen or Councillors may be at a rate not exceeding twelve hundred dollars per annum.

AND WHEREAS the population of the Municipality of Burnaby as at the thirty-first day of December, 1950, is estimated to be fifty-five thousand.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That paragraph (1) of the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1928, being By-law No. 690 of the Corporation, as amended by By-law No. 2050 of the Corporation, be further amended by striking out the words and figures "Four thousand (\$4000.00) dollars" where they appear in the second line thereof, and that the words and figures "Six thousand (\$6000.00) dollars" be substituted therefor.
2. That paragraph (1) of the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1928, being By-law No. 690 of the Corporation, as amended by By-law No. 2050 of the Corporation, be further amended by striking out the words and figures "One thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars" where they appear in the fourth line thereof and that the words and figures "Twelve hundred (\$1200.00) dollars" be substituted therefor.

3. Paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof shall be deemed to have been in effect as from the First (1st) day of January, A.D. 1951.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INDEMNITY BY-LAW 1928, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1951."

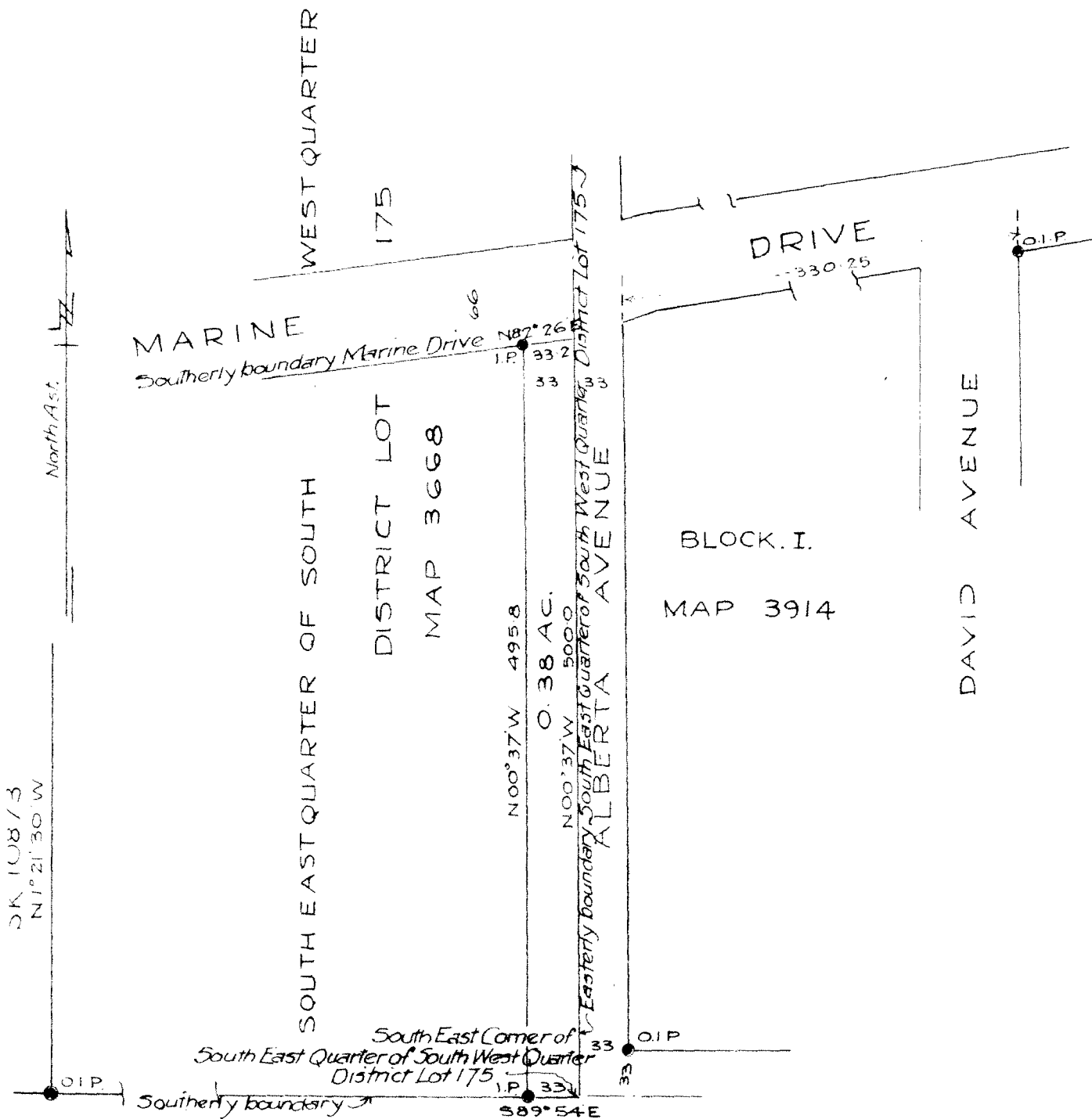
REFERENCE PLAN
