THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3105.

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to convey the hereinafter described lands to the Burnaby Hospital Society.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter referred to became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby at Tax Sale in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burn aby under the terms of By-law No. 3088 dedicated and set aside the hereinafter described lands for a Hospital site.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the said lands should be conveyed to the Burnaby Hospital Society.

THEREFORE The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. The municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby be and is hereby authorized to convey to the Burnaby Hospital Society ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia, and composed of Lot One (1) of Block Twenty-six (26) of District Lot Sixty eight (68) Group One (1) Map No. 11556, for the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar of lawful money of Canada.
- 2. That upon the coming into force of this By-law, the Reeve and Clerk of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, be authorized to execute and deliver to the said Burnaby Hospital Society a conveyance of the said lands under the Seal of the Corporation.
- 3. This By-law shall come into force upon registration thereof in the manner required by law.

This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 3, 1951 (Burnaby Hospital Site)".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council the Nineteenth (19th) day of February, A.D. 1951.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of the Municipal Council on the Twenty-sixth (26th) day of February, A.D. 1951.
