

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3106

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain property within the Municipality and to dedicate the same and other lands for lane or highway purposes.

WHEREAS George Thomas Rule and Joan Lois Rule, of 1929 Kingsway in the Municipality of Burnaby are the owners of land and premises described as Lot eight (8), Block twenty-two (22), District Lot One hundred and Fifty-nine (159), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1241, and have signified their willingness to convey the South ten (10) feet thereof to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby for highway purposes, free and clear of all encumbrances.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation is desirous of accepting a conveyance or other form of transfer from the said George Thomas Rule and Joan Lois Rule.

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation and the Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from the said George Thomas Rule and Joan Lois Rule, a conveyance of the South ten (10) feet of Lot eight (8), Block twenty-two (22), District Lot One hundred and Fifty-nine (159), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1241, free and clear of all encumbrances.

2. That upon receipt of the said Conveyance from the said George Thomas Rule and Joan Lois Rule free and clear of all encumbrance they shall be paid the sum of One dollar.

3. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby further enacts that the said South ten (10) feet of Lot eight (8), Block twenty-two (22), District Lot One hundred and Fifty-nine (159), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1241, when acquired by the said Corporation shall be and is hereby dedicated as a highway to and for the free use of the public in all time hereafter.

4. The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby further enacts that the lands and premises owned by the Corporation and described as follows: ALL AND SINGULAR that certain

parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being the South thirty-three (33) feet of the South Part (Four decimal Eighteen (4.18) Acres more or less) of Block twenty-three (23) of District Lots One hundred and Fifty-two (152) and One hundred and Fifty-three (153) Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 783 as shown and outlined red on sketch deposited No. 1639. shall be deemed to be and is hereby dedicated as a highway to and for the free use of the public in all time hereafter.

5. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION AND ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1951."
