

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3108

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926."

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Paragraph (13) of Section 157 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

(13) "Pressure Atomizing," and "Rotary" Oil Burners shall be of a type approved by the Canadian Standard Association, under Regulations passed by the Authority of the Electrical Energy Inspection Act, Chapter 107 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948.

2. Section 157 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby further amended by adding as paragraph (13a), the following:

(13a) No Oil Burner shall be installed in connection with any Hot Air Furnace, Hot Water, or Steam Boiler, unless the Furnace, or Boiler, is mounted on an incombustible base, pursuant to paragraph (15) hereof.

3. Paragraph (15) of Section 157 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

(15) "Furnace room floor" shall be constructed of brick, cement, or other incombustible material. Where Furnace room floor is not so constructed it shall be protected by an incombustible covering not less than twelve inches in thickness, composed of one layer not less than two inches, in thickness of concrete, over which shall be a layer of six-inch hollow tile laid in cement mortar in such a way that the ducts of the tile will form continuous air-spaces from end to end, and a third layer, consisting of fire brick laid in fireclay. This floor covering shall extend 18" beyond the sides and rear of the furnace or boiler and a distance of 36" from the front of the furnace or boiler.

4. Paragraph (15) of Section 158 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

(15) "Vaporizing Pot-Type Oil Burners" shall be of a type approved by a recognized laboratory. "Approved" means listed or labelled under the inspection serial of:

- (1) Canadian Standard Association, or
- (2) Underwriters' Laboratories of Canada, or
- (3) Factory Mutual Laboratories, or
- (4) Underwriters' Laboratories Incorporated.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1926, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1951."
