

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3121.

A BY-LAW to amend Burnaby Pool-Rooms By-law 1913

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. "Burnaby Pool-Rooms By-law 1913" being By-law No. 149 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by striking out the words "in the afternoon" where they appear in the first and second lines of paragraph (3) thereof, and by substituting therefor the word "midnight".

2. Paragraph (4) of the Burnaby Pool-Rooms By-law 1913, being By-law No. 149 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
"Provided however, that any automatic vending machine licensed pursuant to the "Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine By-law, 1946", being By-law No. 1914 of the Corporation shall be permitted in any pool-room."

3. Paragraph (2) of the Burnaby Pool-Rooms By-law 1913 being By-law No. 149 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

"It shall be an offence against the provisions of this By-law for any youth to be or remain on the premises of any pool-room."

4. This By-law shall come into force upon registration in the manner required by law.

5. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY POOL-ROOMS BY-LAW 1913 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1951."
