## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY-LAW NO. 3142

A BY-LAW to authorize the expenditure of \$20,000.00 out of the special for \$20,000.00 out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 537 of the "Municipal Act" for the construction of a Fire Hall within the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Corporation has by By-law No. 1951 authorized the setting aside of all monies derived from the sale of Tax Sale lands, and the said monies have been deposited in a special account in the Royal Bank of Canada at New Westminster, B.C.

AND WHEREAS the amount standing to the credit of the said special account as at the Twelfth (12th) day of July, 1951, amounts to \$96,709.41

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable that the sum of \$20,000.00 should be used for the construction of a Fire Hall within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of said Section 537, Paragraph (1) it is provided that the money and any interest thereon so set aside under the provisions of the Section shall not be used for any purpose except:

- For bringing the sinking funds up to requirements where the sinking funds on hand are less than requirements.
- (b)
- For the reduction of debenture debt, and For expenditure of a capital or other special nature.

AND WHEREAS the requirements for Sinking Fund purposes are up to requirements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- The sum of \$20,000.00 being part of monies set aside under the provisions of Section 537 by By-law No. 1951 is hereby appropriated for the construction of a Fire Hall within the Municipality.
- The works to be undertaken with funds hereby appropriated, shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Municipal Council

- (3) The Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation are hereby empowered to do all necessary acts and things to give effect to transfer and use of funds hereby authorized.
- (4) This By-law shall come into force and effect upon receiving approval of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.
- (5) This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX SALE LANDS MONIES EXPENDITURE BY-LAW NO. 4, 1951."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council on the Twelfth (12th) day of July, A.D. 1951.
