

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3158

A BY-LAW to provide for the opening of a poll in advance of the regular poll, for the Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Section 22 of the Municipal Elections Act provides that the Council of a District Municipality may provide for the holding of a poll in advance of the regular poll for the Municipal Election.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient that the said poll be established.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That an advance poll for the Municipal Election be opened by the Returning Officer and be kept open during the hours from 10:00 o'clock A. M. to 3:00 o'clock P. M. on each of the days Thursday and Friday of the week following the week in which nominations are held.

2. The persons who shall be permitted to vote on the first two days of the poll -- namely, the Thursday and Friday -- as mentioned in Paragraph (1), shall be those only who are duly qualified voters and who shall sign a statement showing that it is their expectation that they will be absent from the municipality on the final day of the poll.

3. This By-law shall be cited as "BURNABY ADVANCE POLL BY-LAW 1951."
