

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3159

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain property within the Municipality and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

WHEREAS it is necessary and advisable that the hereinafter lands should be acquired by The Corporation to provide for lane allowance.

AND WHEREAS the said hereinafter mentioned lands are owned by Franklin Sparling Sarjeant.

AND WHEREAS Franklin Sparling Sarjeant has agreed to convey the said lands to The Corporation for the aforesaid purpose for the sum of Two hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) dollars.

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, in open meeting ENACTS as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful and The Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from Franklin Sparling Sarjeant a conveyance of ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as the North ten (10') feet of Lot Eighteen (18) of Block Four (4) of subdivision of part of District Lot One hundred and fifty eight (158) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1501.
2. That upon registration of the said conveyance, the lands and premises thereby conveyed, shall be deemed to be and are hereby dedicated as a highway, to and for the free use of the public for all time thereafter.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes, as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION AND ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1951."
