A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Trades License By-law 1950", Numbered 3089.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Clause 132 of Schedule "A" of the said By-law No. 3089 is amended by inserting after "moving picture theatre" in the second line the words "drive-in theatre"; and by striking out the words "(allowing 704 square inches for each seat)" in the fourth and fifth lines, and substituting "(allowing 704 square inches for each seat and, in the case of drive-in theatres, three seats to each motor-vehicle parking-space)".

2. Clause 55 of Schedule "A" of the said By-law is amended by striking out the present wording and substituting the following:

> "From every person carrying on the business of a gasoline service station, the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for each gasoline pump installation provided, however, the minimum license fee for any gasoline service station shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00), every six months. It is further provided that this clause shall not apply to any person who operates a garage and pays a license therefor."

3. Clause 65 of Schedule "A" of the said By-law is amended by striking out the words "Fifty Dollars" in the second line and substituting the following words, "Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)."

4. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the Fifteenth (15th) day of January, A. D. 1952.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY TRADES LICENSE BY-LAW, 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1951."
