

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW No. 3174

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire easements for Corporate purposes

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that easements should be acquired through the hereinafter mentioned lands for the purpose of constructing drainage ditches.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the said land have agreed to grant easements to the Corporation for the aforesaid purpose.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of paragraph (2) of Paragraph (19) of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act", R.S.B.C. 1948 the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an easement from each of the owners of the lands and premises set forth in the Schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law, for a right of way for a drainage ditch through and over the said lands, paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW No. 1. 1952".

Name of Owner	Description of property
The Director, Veteran's Land Act	East eight (8') feet of Block 24, of District Lot 83, Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No.1267.
The Director, Veteran's Land Act	Westerly five (5') feet of the West half of a 4 acre portion (Sketch 1108) of Lot Thirty five (25) Group 1. being all that part of said 4 acre portion lying to the west of a straight line bisecting the North and South boundaries thereof, New Westminster District.
