

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired through the hereinafter mentioned property for the purpose of right of way for a drainage ditch.

AND WHEREAS Charles Gavin Hyde, of the Municipality of Burnaby is the owner of Lot Twelve (12) of subdivision of Lots Thirty (30) to Thirty four (34) inclusive of District Lot Ninety eight (98), Group One (1) New Westminster District, Plan No. 2066;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Charles Gavin Hyde has agreed to grant an easement for right of way for a drainage ditch through and over the hereinbefore mentioned property;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Paragraph (a) of Paragraph (19) of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act" R.S.B.C. 1948 the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an easement from Charles Gavin Hyde, of the Municipality of Burnaby, for a right of way for a drainage ditch through and over the West five (5') feet of Lot Twelve (12) of subdivision of Lots Thirty (30) to Thirty four (34) inclusive of District Lot Ninety eight (98) Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan No. 2066 having a frontage of 5 feet on Watling Street and extending with uniform width for the full depth of said Lot 12, paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1952."
