

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3196

A BY-LAW to amend "Burnaby Electrical Inspection By-law 1928", being By-law No. 761 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Paragraph 17 of the "Burnaby Electrical Inspection By-law 1928", being By-law No. 761 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"17. All persons making application for permits to install, construct, alter, repair, or maintain any electrical works in the Municipality shall pay to the Collector of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby the fees as set out in Sections 3, 4, and 6, of the Regulations governing Electrical Permits and Inspection Fees as passed by Order in Council No. 15, dated January 7th, 1950, under the "Electrical Energy Inspection Act", and amendments thereto.

2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon registration thereof.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ELECTRICAL INSPECTION BY-LAW 1928 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1952."

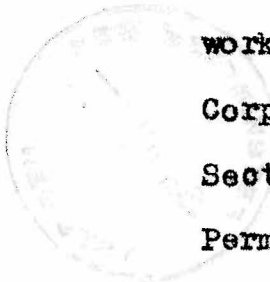
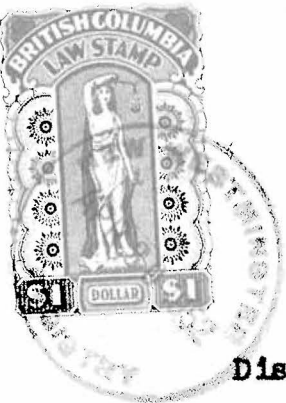
