THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3201

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound By-law, 1935", numbered 1515.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. Clause (b) of Section 2 of "Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound By-law, 1935", numbered 1515, is amended by adding the word "apparently" after the word "dog" in the first line.

2. The said By-law is further amended by adding the following clause to Section 2 to be known as Clause (k):

(k) "Run at large" shall mean to be free or unrestricted and not being under the immediate charge and control of a responsible and competent person; "running at large" and "at large" shall have a corresponding meaning.

3. Section 12 of the said By-law is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"No person owning, harbouring or having custody, care or control of any dog, shall allow or suffer such dog to run at large in the Municipality."

4. Section 21 of the said By-law is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"The owner, possessor or harbourer of any dog impounded pursuant to the provisions of this By-law may reclaim such dog on application to the Pound-keeper at any time prior to its sale or destruction on proof of ownership and on payment of the following charges:

(a) If no license has been taken out, prior to the date the dog was impounded, by the owner of the dog for the current year, the impounding fee shall not exceed the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) together with the prescribed license fee.

(b) If a license has been taken out by the owner of the dog for the current year, prior to the date the dog was impounded, the impounding fee shall not exceed the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00).

5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND BY-LAW 1935 AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1952."
