

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3209

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1772 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby by By-law No. 1772, entitled "Burnaby Park Dedication By-law 1942" dedicated and set aside for Park purposes among other lands ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and being more particularly described as Lots 29 to 32 inclusive, of District Lot 144, Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No. 1534:

AND WHEREAS no public monies have been expended in establishing a Park upon the said lands and the said lands have not been used or established as a Park.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deem it advisable that the dedication of the aforesaid lands should be cancelled:

THEREFORE The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. "Burnaby Park Dedication By-law 1942" being By-law No. 1772 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by striking out in the Schedule attached to the said By-law, the following, viz: Lots 1 to 32 inclusive, of District Lot 144, Map 1534, and by substituting therefor the following: Lots 1 to 28 inclusive, District Lot 144, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 1534.
2. This By-law shall take effect upon registration thereof.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY
