A BY-LAW to further amend "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1943" being By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- l. "Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1943" being By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, is hereby further amended by adding as paragraph "K" to paragraph 18, the following:
 - "(k) It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing, either attended or unattended, any vehicle on the east side of Sperling Avenue between Deer Lake Drive and the Grandview-Douglas Highway, and on the northeast side of Buckingham Avenue from Sperling Avenue easterly for a distance of 500 feet, PROVIDED that the aforementioned areas shall be clearly defined by the placing of proper signs, either on the pavement or on the boulevard adjacent thereto.
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1943 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1952".
