

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3233

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1810.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Paragraph (e) of Paragraph 18 of By-law No. 1810 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Duthie Avenue - Hastings-Barnet Road to Broadway
McDonald Avenue - Oxford Street East intersection

2. Paragraph 7 of By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

PROVIDED that where any new construction, re-construction, widening, repair, marking, or other work is being carried out upon a street, avenue or highway (other than a Provincial Highway) within the Municipality of Burnaby, and where signs are displayed to the effect that such work or works are being carried on, no person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle on such portion of the street, avenue or highway at a greater rate of speed than 10 miles per hour.

3. Paragraph 15 of By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding as subparagraph "j" the following:

(j) No person in control of or operating a motor vehicle on a street, avenue or highway, other than a provincial highway, within the Municipality of Burnaby, shall allow such vehicle to enter upon a pedestrian crossing designated by a sign displaying the words "Pedestrian Crossing" when such crossing is occupied by a pedestrian crossing such street, avenue or highway.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1943, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1952".
