

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3237

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain land within the Municipality of Burnaby, for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 19 of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands.

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient that Lot Nine (9), Block Thirty-one (31), of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-one (121), Group One (1), Plan 1054, New Westminster District, should be acquired for Corporate purposes.

THE COUNCIL for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:


1. That Lot Nine (9), Block Thirty-one (31), of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-one (121), Group One (1), Plan 1054, New Westminster District, be acquired from Melvin Arthur Cullum, of the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by the said Melvin Arthur Cullum to the Corporation he shall be paid the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BY-LAW 1952".
