

BY-LAW NO. 3243

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire easements for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that easements should be acquired through the hereinafter mentioned lands for the purpose of constructing drainage ditches.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the said land have agreed to grant easements to the Corporation for the aforesaid purpose.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of paragraph (a) of Paragraph (19) of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act", R.S.B.C. 1948 the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an easement from each of the owners of the lands and premises set forth in the Schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law, for a right-of-way for a drainage ditch through and over the said lands, paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1952".

SCHEDULE

Description of Property

West Ten (10') feet of Lot Twelve (12), Block Thirty-three (33), District Lot Thirty (30), Group 1, New Westminster District, Map 3036; the said Ten (10') feet having a frontage of Ten (10') feet on 18th Avenue and extending for the full depth of the said Lot and adjoining Lot Thirteen (13).

West Twenty (20') feet of Lot Two (2) of Subdivision of Lot "D" of Block Seventy-one (71) of District Lot Thirty-three (33), Group 1, New Westminster District, according to a map or plan of the said Lot "D" deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster and numbered 8617, having a frontage of 20 feet on Grange Street and extending with uniform width for the full depth of said Lot Two (2).

West Ten (10') feet of Lot Five (5) of Block Thirty-three (33) of District Lot Thirty (30), Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 3036; said Ten (10') feet having a frontage of Ten (10') feet on 19th Avenue and extending for the full depth of lot and adjoining Lot Four (4).

East Five (5') feet of Lot Fifty-five (55), Block Sixteen (16), District Lot Sixty-eight (68), Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 11700.

East Five (5') feet of Lot Fifty-six (56), Block Seventeen (17), District Lot Sixty-eight (68), Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 11700.
