

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3246

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain property within the Municipality of Burnaby and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

WHEREAS The Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited is the owner of land and premises described as Subdivision "A" (Thirty-seven Decimal Three (37.3) acres more or less) of Lot Two Hundred and Seventeen (217), Group One (1), Map No. 1071, Save and Except Part (Forty-four one Hundredths (0.44) of an acre) shewn on Sketch deposited No. 1847 and Save and Except Part (Five Hundred and forty-three One Thousandths (0.543) of an acre) shewn on Sketch deposited No. 1848 heretofore conveyed to the Canadian Pacific Railway in the District of New Westminster.

AND WHEREAS the said Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited has signified its willingness to convey, free from encumbrance, a portion of the said lands and premises to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby (hereinafter referred to as "The Corporation") for highway purposes, all for the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation is desirous of accepting a conveyance or other form of transfer from the said Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited, of the said lands and premises free from encumbrances for the said purpose.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for The Corporation and The Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from the said Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited a conveyance or other form of transfer of ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia, and composed of the Easterly

33' (thirty-three feet) of Subdivision "A" (Thirty-seven Decimal Three (37.3) acres more or less) of Lot Two Hundred and Seventeen (217) Group One (1), Map 1071, Save and Except Part (Forty-four One Hundredths (0.44) of an acre) shewn on Sketch deposited No. 1847 and Save and Except Part (Five Hundred and forty-three One Thousandths (0.543) of an acre) shewn on Sketch deposited No. 1848 heretofore conveyed to the Canadian Pacific Railway in the District of New Westminster.

2. That upon execution and delivery of a conveyance or other form of transfer by the said Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited, free and clear of all encumbrance, to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, the said Shell Oil Company of Canada Limited shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. That upon registration of the said conveyance or other form of transfer, by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, the lands and premises conveyed by and described therein shall be deemed to be and are hereby dedicated as a highway to and for the free use of the public in all time thereafter.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Burnaby ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1952."
