

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3257

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire easements for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that easements should be acquired through the hereinafter mentioned lands for the purpose of constructing sewers.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the said lands have agreed to grant easements to the Corporation for the afore-said purpose.

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Paragraph (a) of Paragraph (19) of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act", R.S.B.C. 1948 the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an easement from each of the owners of the lands and premises set forth in the Schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law, for a right-of-way for a sewer through and over the said lands, for the consideration as shown in the said Schedule.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1952".

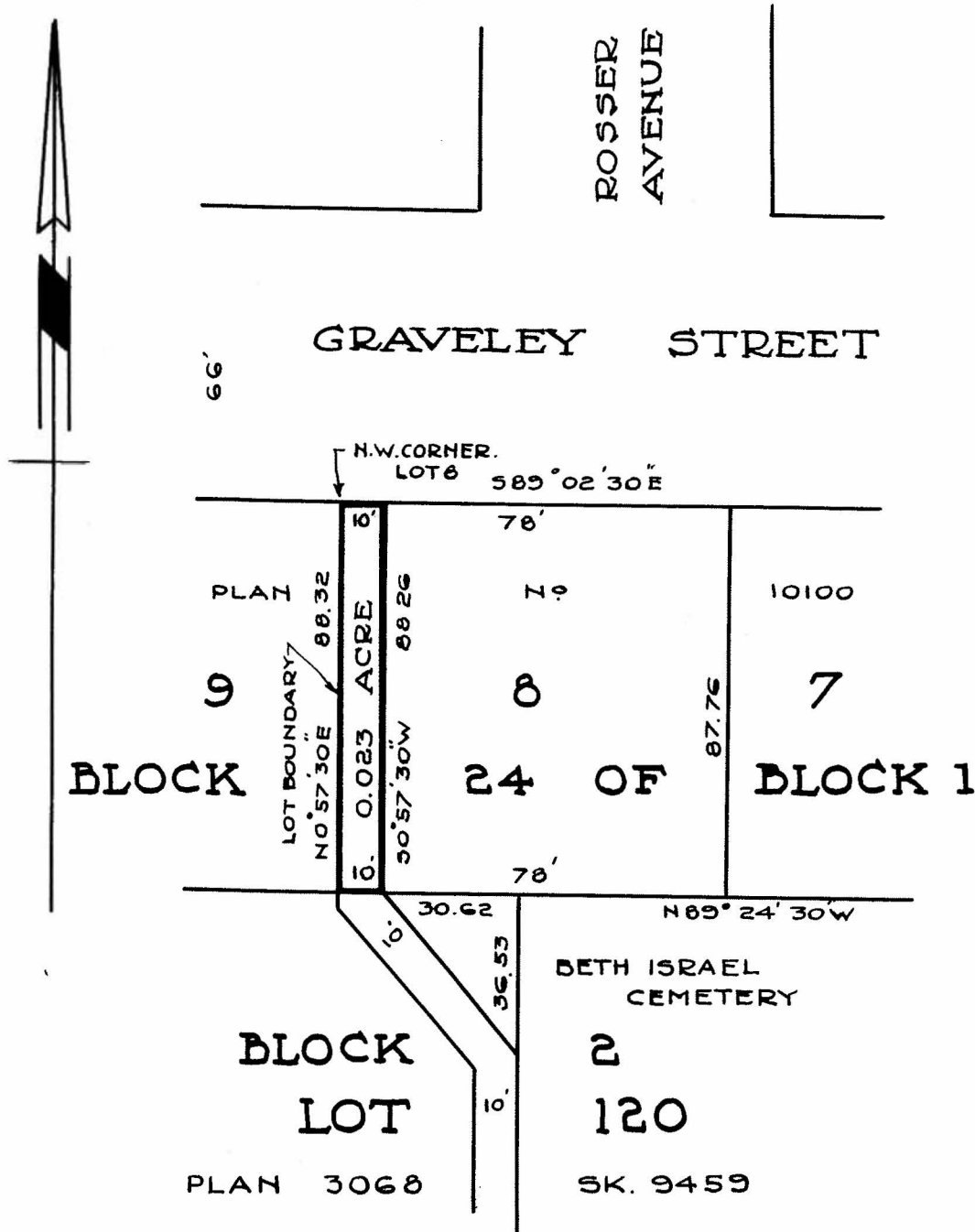
PLAN OF A PORTION OF LOT 8,
