THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3262

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of a Five (5¹) foot Portland cement concrete sidewalk upon the north side of Kingsway from the lane East of Pioneer Avenue East to Sussex Avenue, and a Portland cement concrete sidewalk four (4¹) feet wide, upon the West side of Sussex Avenue from Kingsway north for a distance 105.4 feet, as a Local Improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

WHEREAS Lucy E. Luterback and others have petitioned the Council to construct, as a local improvement, the work hereinafter described, and the Clerk has certified that the petition is sufficient, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition in the manner hereinafter provided.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- (1) That a Portland cement concrete sidewalk Five (5') feet wide, be constructed upon the North side of Kingsway from the lane East of Pioneer Avenue East to Sussex Avenue, and a Portland cement concrete sidewalk four (4') feet wide be constructed upon the West side of Sussex Avenue from Kingsway north for a distance of 105.4 feet, as a local improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".
- (2) The Engineer of The Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles, and specifications and furnish such improvement as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- (3) The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- (4) The Reeve and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered

into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.

- (5) The Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- (6) The special assessment shall be paid by five annual instalments.
- (7) The debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at four and one-half $(4\frac{1}{2}\%)$ per centum per annum, and be made payable within five years on the serial plan.
- (8) Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.
- (9) This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 18, 1952".
