THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3264

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired through the hereinafter mentioned property for the purpose of right of way for a drainage ditch.

AND WHEREAS Gladys Effic Marshall, of the City of Vancouver, and Douglas John Baker and Rita Baker, both of the Municipality of Burnaby are the owners of Lot Eight (8), of Block Eight (8) of the North portion of District Lot Ninety four (94N.) Group One (1), Map No. 1117, New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Gladys Effie Marshall and Douglas John Baker and Rita Baker have agreed to grant an easement for right of way for a drainage ditch through and over the hereinbefore mentioned property;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Paragraph (a) of Paragraph (19) of Section 58 of the "Municipal Act"

R.S.B.C. 1948 the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-laws to acquire or accept easements.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an easement from Gladys Effic Marshall, of the City of Vancouver, and Douglas John Baker and Rita Baker, both of the Municipality of Burnaby, for a right of way for a drainage ditch through and over:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as the South Eight (8') Feet of Lot Eight (8), of Block Eight (8) of the North portion of District Lot Ninety four (94N.) Group One (1), Map No. 1117, New Westminster District paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful money

of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1952."
