

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3407

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No.1810

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Paragraph (h) of Paragraph 15 of By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding after the word "curb" in the second line the following:

"Provided that it shall be lawful for a vehicle to be parked at right angles to the curb or sidewalk at any of the following places, viz:

- On Joffre Street East side from Rumble Street south 110 feet.
- On Rumble Street, North side from 160 feet west of Royal Oak Avenue to 130 feet East of Royal Oak Avenue.
- On Sixth Street, North east side from 13th Avenue to 10th Avenue.
- On Sunset Street - both sides from Smith Avenue to Ingleton Avenue, excluding portion on North side adjacent to Service Station Driveway.
- On Boundary Road, East side from Norfolk Street to Dominion Street.
- On Madison Avenue, West side from Charles Street to Williams Street.
- On Schou Street, South side from Boundary Road to 125 feet east."

2. Sub-Paragraph "J" of Paragraph 18 of By-law No. 1810 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by striking out the schedule annexed thereto and by substituting therefore the following:

ONE HOUR PARKING AREA:

- (a) The South side of Hastings Street from Boundary Road to Willingdon Avenue.
- (b) Esmond Avenue, from 120 feet south of Hastings Street to 120 feet North of Hastings Street.
- (c) McDonald Avenue, from 120 feet south of Hastings Street to 120 feet North of Hastings Street.
- (d) Ingleton Avenue, from 120 feet south of Hastings Street to 120 feet North of Hastings Street.
- (e) Gilmore Avenue from 120 feet south of Hastings St. to 120 feet north of Hastings Street.
- (f) Carleton Avenue from 120 feet south of Hastings Street to 120 feet north of Hastings Street.
- (g) Madison Avenue from 120 feet south of Hastings St. to 120 feet north of Hastings Street.
- (h) Rosser Avenue from 120 feet south of Hastings St. to 120 feet north of Hastings Street.

between the hours of nine o'clock a.m. and six o'clock p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays of each week,

and between the hours of nine o'clock a.m. and one o'clock p.m. on Wednesday of each week, PROVIDED further that the provisions of this section shall not apply on any Statutory Holiday.

3. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1943 Amendment By-law No.6, 1953."
