BY-LAW NO. 3434

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1772 of The Corporation of The District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS The Corporation of The District of Burnaby By-law No. 1772, entitled "Burnaby Park Dedication By-law 1942" dedicated and set aside for Park purposes among other lands ALL AND SINGULAN those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia and being more particularly described as Lots One (1) to Twenty-four (24) inclusive, of District Lot One Hundred and Forty-four (144), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1534.

AND WHEREAS no public monies have been expended in establishing a Park upon the said lands and the said lands have not been used or established as a Park.

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby deem it advisable that the dedication of the aforesaid lands should be cancelled:

of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. "Burnaby Park Dedication By-law 1942" being Bylaw No. 1772 of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby as amended by By-law No. 3209, is hereby further amended by striking out in the Schedule attached to the said By-law, the following, viz: Lots One (1) to Twenty-eight (28) inclusive, of District Lot One Hundred and Forty-four (144), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1534, and by substituting therefore, the following Lots Twenty-five (25) to Twenty-eight (28) inclusive, **B**istrict Lot of One Hundred and Forty-four (144⁷, Group One (1), New Westminster District Map No. 1534.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon registration thereof.

3. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1942 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1954"
