

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3482

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of pavements and other works as local improvements under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

WHEREAS separate petitions have been received by the Municipal Council to construct as local improvements the respective works hereinafter described and the Clerk has certified that the respective petitions are sufficient, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of such petitions in manner hereinafter provided;

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows: -

1. The following works shall be constructed as local improvements under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

A. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Hurst Street from Willingdon Avenue to Patterson Avenue.

B. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Willingdon Avenue from Victory Street to Watling Street.

C. That an Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Beresford Street from Buller Avenue to McPherson Avenue.

D. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on 17th Avenue from Britton Avenue to 16th Street.

E. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Gray Avenue from Carson Street to McKee Street.

F. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Daisey Avenue from Beresford Street South 389'.

G. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Avondale Street from Boundary Road to Smith Avenue.

H. That An Asphalt Pavement 20 feet wide be constructed on Brandon Street from Smith Avenue to 110.3' west of Belleville Street.

2. The Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such

plans, profiles, and specifications and furnish such improvement as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.

3. The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.

4. The Reeve and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.

5. The Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.

6. The special assessment shall be paid by two annual instalments.

7. The debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at four (4%) per centum per annum, and be made payable within two years on the serial plan.

8. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without the interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.

9. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 13, 1954".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council the Twelfth (12th) day of July, A. D. 1954.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of the Municipal Council on the Twenty-sixth (26th) day of July, A. D. 1954.
