THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 3483

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire Easements for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient that Easements be acquired for right-of-way for the installation of Sewers, through and across the lands and premises, as set out in the Schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the said respective parcels of land as set out in the said Schedule have agreed to grant an Easement through and over their respective properties.

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 19 (a) of Section 58 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1948, Chapter 232 authorizes the Council of any Municipality to pass by-laws to acquire easements from any person for and to the use of the Municipality.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- l. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for the purpose of a right-of-way for the construction of a sewer from the owners of lands and premises as set out in the Schedule attached hereto and hereby incorporated and made part of this By-law, paying therefor such sums of money as may be mutually agreed upon between the Corporation and the said respective owners.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force on the registration thereof.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1954".

BURNABY EASEMENT AUTHORIZATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1954.

SCHEDULE

1. All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being the Northerly Ten (N.10') feet of Block Eighteen (18) of District Lot Twenty-nine (29), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 3035, save and except Parcel A, (0.351 of an acre), Reference Plan No. 5143, and save and except part sub-divided on Plan No. 10745.






