THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3502

A BY-LAW to provide for a special account and to amend "Burnaby District Improvement By-law No. 3, 1953".

WHEHEAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 65 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 232, R.S.B.C. 1948, By-law No. 3326, being a By-law to define the District Improvement area in portion of District Lots Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30), Ninety-One (91), Ninety-five (95) and Ninety-six (96), in the Municipality of Burnaby, and to provide for the execution of certain works thereon, was duly passed by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, on the 1st day of June, 1953, and was duly amended by By-law No. 3360, being a By-law to amend the said "Burnaby District Improvement By-law No. 3, 1953", Bylaw No. 3326, passed by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby on the 15th day of July 1953.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the terms of the aforesaid By-law No. 3326, as amended, the sum of Three hundred and ninetytwo thousand (\$392,000.00) dollars was raised by way of loan and debentures were issued therefor.

AND WHEREAS the work for which the monies in the sum of Three Hundred and ninety-two thousand (\$392,000.00) dollars was borrowed, that is to say, the works recited in the said By-law No. 3326, have been completed in the manner set out in Schedule "A" attached to and incorporated with the said By-law No. 3326, as amended have been fully paid.

AND WHEREAS the sum of Ninety-three thousand, five hundred and thirteen dollars (\$93,513.00) remains standing on the books of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby as the unexpended balance of the said Three hundred and ninety-two thousand (\$392,000.00) dollars so borrowed.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby in open meeting assembled ENACTS as follows:

1. That the aforesaid sum of Ninety-three thousand, five hundred and thirteen dollars (\$93,513.00) be placed in a special account.

2. That the said monies shall be used to redeem and retire the dehentures is sued pursuant to By-law No. 3326 as the said debentures mature as follows:

3. That the annual amounts to be raised and levied in each year during the currency of the said debentures as referred to in Section 4 of  $^{13}$ y-law No. 3326 be reduced by the amounts referred to in Section 2 herein in each year reppectively.

4. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon receipt of approval of the Inspector of Municipalities, and after registration in a manner required by law.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY SPECIAL ACCOUNT FOR THE RETIREMENT OF BEBENTURES BY-LAW 1954".
