A BY-Lair ror disposine of a portion of a public Highway in exchance for adjacent lerds necessary for diverting such Highway.

WHERAS Charles Boyer brown is the ower of land described in Clause 2 of this By-law and has agreed with The Corporation of the Diatrict of Bumeby to make the exchange hereinefter provided for.

THERFORE the wunicipel Council of the Comporetion of the District of Burnaby ENAOPS as follows:

1. Upon receivine from the said Chames Eoyer Erow the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Clause 2 hereof, the Reeve and Clerk of The Corporation are hereby autborized, in exchange therefor, to execute ard deliver on behalf of The Corporation such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in Charles Boyer Erown and Lillian Eermecia Erown, Joint Tenants, AJU AD sIrGULAR thet certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being a portion of 16 root lane adjacent to the southerly boundary of Lots siehty-four (34), Eichty-five (85), and Lighty-six (86), of Lote Two (2) to Seven (7), of Blocks One (1) and Three (3), District Lot Ninety-Five (95), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Province of British Columbia, according to rlan 1056 deposited, as shew on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in green colour.
2. For the purpose of diverting a public lane or highway, the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to accept from the seid Charles Boyer Brow, in exchange for the lands mentioned in clause 1 hereof such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the crom as a public highway aju and smudar thet certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the wnicipality of Eumaby, Province of british Col-
umbia, and being more particularly described as:

Second, All that portion of Lot rive (5) subdivision of Lot "R" of Lots Two (2) to Seven (7) of Block numbered One (1) to Three (3) of District Lot Ninety-five (95) Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 14335 comencing at the north-west comer of said Lot five (5), thence North eighty-nine degrees, fifty-seven minutes east (N. $89^{\circ} 57^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$ ) fifty-two and seven tenths (52.7) feet more or less to the north east corner of said Lot Five (5), thence South nine and thirty-five one hundredths feet ( $9.35^{\circ}$ ); thence South Seventy-five degrees, twenty-eight minutes West (S.75028'W) Twenty-four and eleven onehundredths feet (24.11'); thence north Seventy-eight degrees, forty-one minutes West (N.78.41'W) Twenty-nine and ninety-five one hundredths feet (29.95') more or less, thence North nine and forty-five one hundredths feet (9.45') more or less to the point of commencement, containing by admeasurement 0.015 acres be the same more or less and outlined in red on the plan hereunto annexed.

Third: All that portion of Lot "N", of Lots Two (2) to Seven (7) of Block Numbered One (1) to Three (3) of District Lot $\mathbb{N}_{\text {inety-five (95), Group One (1), New Westminster }}$ District, Miap No. 13742 , commencing at the north-west corner of Lot "N"; thence North eighty-nine degrees, fiftyseven minutes East ( $\mathbb{N} .8907^{\circ}$ E) Thirty-six and two tenths feet (36.2\%); thence south seventy-fi ve degrees, twentyeight minutes (S.75028') West, Thirty-seven and thirtynine one hundredths feet (37.39') more or less to the west boundary of said Lot "N"; thence north Nine and thirtyfive one hundredths feet' $\left(9.3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ more or less to the point of commencement, containing by admeasurement 0.004 fore acres be the same more or less and outlined in red on the plan hereunto annexed.
