

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3518

A BY-LAW for disposing of a portion of a public highway in exchange for adjacent lands necessary for diverting such highway.

WHEREAS James William Kenyon and Mary Beatrice Kenyon are the owners of land described in Clause 2 of this By-law and have agreed with The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to make the exchange hereinafter provided for.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Upon receiving from the said James William Kenyon and Mary Beatrice Kenyon the Conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Clause 2 hereof the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation are hereby authorized in exchange therefor to execute and deliver on behalf of the Corporation such Conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said James William Kenyon and Mary Beatrice Kenyon ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being a portion of road, having a full width of ten (10.0) feet, lying adjacent to the North-westerly boundary of Lot Sixteen (16), of Blocks One Hundred and Six (106), One Hundred and Seven (107), One Hundred and Nineteen (119), and One Hundred and Twenty (120), District Lot Eighty-six (86), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan 1423, deposited, and being contained within the North-westerly productions of the South-westerly and North-easterly Boundaries thereof, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in Green colour.

2. For the purpose of diverting a public lane or highway the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to accept from the said James William Kenyon and Mary Beatrice Kenyon in

exchange for the lands mentioned in Clause 1 hereof such Conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being the South-easterly ten (10.0) feet of Block One Hundred and Five (105), District Lot Eighty-six (86), Group One (1), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan 1203, deposited and being more particularly described as a portion of said Block One Hundred and Five (105), having a full width of ten (10.0) feet, and lying adjacent to the South-easterly boundary thereof, as shown on the Plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined with Red colour.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 6, 1954".

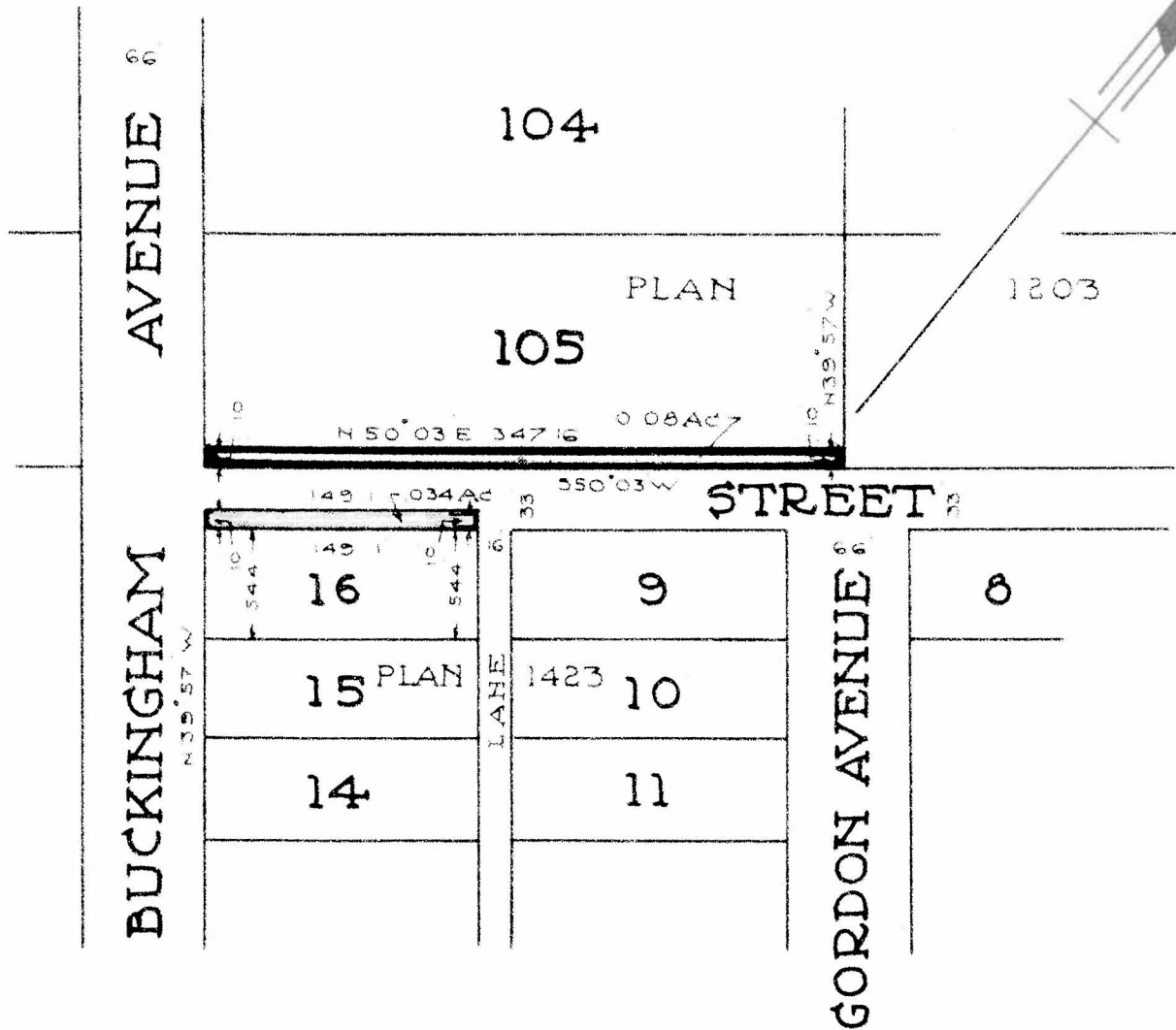
