

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3520

A BY-LAW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain property within the Municipality of Burnaby and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

WHEREAS George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore are the owners of land and premises described as Lot One (1), of Lot Three (3), Block "A", District Lot Ninety-One (91), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map 1346.

AND WHEREAS the said George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore have signified their willingness to convey, free from encumbrance, a portion of the said land and premises to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby (hereinafter referred to as "The Corporation") for highway purposes, all for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation is desirous of accepting a conveyance or other form of transfer from the said George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore, of a portion of the said land and premises free from encumbrances for the said purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for The Corporation and The Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from the said George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore a conveyance or other form of transfer of ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as the Easterly ten (10) feet of Lot One (1), of Lot Three (3), Block "A", District Lot Ninety-One (91), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map 1346, having a uniform width extending the full

width of said lot and adjoining Lot Forty (40), Group One (1), New Westminster District.

2. That upon execution and delivery of a conveyance or other form of transfer by the said George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore, free and clear of all encumbrance, to The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, the said George Henry Moore and Edith Mary Moore shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. That upon registration of the said conveyance or other form of transfer, by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby, the land and premises conveyed by and described therein shall be deemed to be and are hereby dedicated as a highway to and for the free use of the public in all time thereafter.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1954."
