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A BY-MW to authorize The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to grant an easement trough and ovor certain lands within the Municipality on Bumaby to the British Columbia Telep Company.


#### Abstract

WIEREAS the Britiah Columbia Telephone Company is desirous of obtaining an easement over certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for the purpose of laying an underground telephone cable.


AFD NHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby is the owner in fee of certain lands hereinafter mentioned through and over which the said easement or right of way is required.

AIS WEERAS under tine provisions of sub-section 204 of Section 50, of the Phanicipal Act R.s.3.C. 1948, the Thacipal Council is authorized to make and pess a by-law for ranting an easement for any purpose, for or without any consideration, over any real property of the Municipality for and to the use of any person.

THEREROE the Manicipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby MTACRS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Manicipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby to grant unto the British Columbia Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, an easement through, under and across the hereinafter described property for the purpose of laying and maintaining an underground telephone cable, and to receive in payment therefor the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar.

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being a portion of Parcel " ${ }_{G}$ " of District Lots One Fiundred and Twenty-three (123) and One Hundred and Twenty-four (1<4), Group One (I), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan 13725 , deposited and beinc more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeasterly corner of Lot Five (5) of Block One Hundred and Three (103), according to Plan 144ll deposited;

Thence Eastwardly and following the Easterly production of the Northerly boundary of said Lot Five (5), Five (5.0) feet;
