BY-LAW NO. 3523

A BY-LAW to authorize the holding of certain referendums.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 58, Subsection 216, of the Municipal Act, it is provided inter alia that a Municipal Council may pass a by-law for obtaining at the time of holding the annual election the opinion of the Municipal electors upon any question which affects the Municipality and with which the Municipal Council has power to deal and for regulating the mode of so obtaining such opinion.

AND WHEREAS this Council deems it advisable to obtain the opinion of the Municipal electors upon the questions enumerated hereunder which affect the Municipality and with which this Council has power to deal.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That the questions enumerated hereunder be submitted for the opinion of the Municipal electors at the annual election to be held on the Eleventh (11th) day of December, 1954.

(a) Are you in favor of the election of a Board of Park Commissioners.

(b) Are you in favor of the construction of the first unit of a new Municipal Hall at an estimated cost of \$380,000.00 to be provided out of tax sale monies?

(c) Are you in favor of the location of the new Municipal Hall being Block 8, District Lot 79 South, Map 536, situated immediately east of the Valley View Community Centre on the Grandview-Douglas Highway.

2. That John H. Shaw be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of taking the vote of the

said electors on the Eleventh (11th) day of December, 1954 and that the times and places of voting be the same as set for the annual election.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY REFERENDUM BY-LAW, 1954".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty-second(22nd) day of November , 1954.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED this Twenty-ninth (29th) day of November , 1954.
