BY-LAW NO. 3567

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 540, being
the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926".

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 29 of By-law No. 540 as enacted by
By-law No. 3195 is repealed and the following substituted
therefor:

"29. The fees for the issuance of any permit shall
be determined by the cost of the proposed construction,
erection, alteration or repair as follows:

When the cost does not exceed \$200.00	\$ 2.00
When the cost exceeds \$200.00, but does not exceed \$500.00	3.00
When the cost exceeds \$500.00, but does not exceed \$1,000.00	4.00
When the cost exceeds \$1,000.00, but does not exceed \$2,000.00	6.00
When the cost exceeds \$2,000.00, but does not exceed \$3,000.00	8.00
When the cost exceeds \$3,000.00, but does not exceed \$4,000.00	10.00
When the cost exceeds \$4,000.00, but does not exceed \$5,000.00	11.75
When the cost exceeds \$5,000.00, but does not exceed \$6,000.00	13.50
When the cost exceeds \$6,000.00, but does not exceed \$7,000.00	16.00
When the cost exceeds \$7,000.00, but does not exceed \$8,000.00	17.75
When the cost exceeds \$8,000.00, but does not exceed \$9,000.00,	19.50
When the cost exceeds \$9,000.00, but does not exceed \$10,000.00	21.25
When the cost exceeds \$10,000.00, but does not exceed \$11,000.00	23.00
When the cost exceeds \$11,000.00, but does not exceed \$12,000.00	24.75

When the cost exceeds \$12,000.00, but does not exceed \$13,000.00	\$26.50
When the cost exceeds \$13,000.00, but does not exceed \$14,000.00	28.25
When the cost exceeds \$14,000.00, but does not exceed \$15,000.00	30.00

and \$1.00 additional shall be payable
for every \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof
in excess of \$15,000.00

2. Section 344 as enacted by By-law No. 1548
is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"344. Notwithstanding the terms of section 29 hereof,
there are hereby levied upon and there shall be paid by
every applicant for a permit to install any oil-burner or
oil-burning equipment in the District of Burnaby the follow-
ing fees and charges namely:

(a) For the installation of a commercial oil burner,
and oil burning equipment connected therewith, a permit fee
of Three Dollars (\$3.00).

(b) For the installation of a domestic oil burner,
and oil burning equipment connected therewith, a permit
fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00).

(c) For the installation of a range oil burner, and
oil burning equipment connected therewith, a permit fee
of Two Dollars (\$2.00).

(d) For the installation of an underground oil
storage tank a permit fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00).

(e) For the installation of a commercial oil burner,
domestic oil burner, or range oil burner, together with
underground storage tank, in conjunction therewith, a
permit fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

(f) For re-inspection of work found to be defective
on the first inspection, or not ready at the time of the
first inspection, or for re-inspection of corrections or
errors in any foregoing inspections, a fee of Two Dollars

and fifty cents (\$2.50) per hour for the time so occupied, and for any time after the first hour at the same rate, except that the minimum fee shall be Two Dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50)."

3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon registration thereof.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1926, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1955".
