

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3616

A BY-LAW to authorize the acquisition of certain lands within the Municipality for and to the use of the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council may make By-laws to acquire lands from any person for and to the use of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient to acquire for such purpose the lands and premises hereinafter described.

AND WHEREAS the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) is the owner of the said lands and premises and has agreed to convey the said lands and premises to the Corporation.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 41 (Burnaby) by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all charges and encumbrances, for and to the use of the Municipality those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby and more particularly hereinafter described paying in consideration therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as being the westerly thirty-three (33) feet of Block Two (2) of Lot One hundred

and fifty-six (156), Group One (1), District of New Westminster, according to Plan 1030 deposited, having a frontage of thirty-three (33) feet on Marine Drive and extending with uniform width for the full depth of Block Two (2) and adjoining the Westerly boundary thereof and containing 0.375 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown outlined in red colour on the plan prepared by Geoffrey K. Burnett, B.C.L.S. and dated the 4th day of July, 1955 and filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1955".

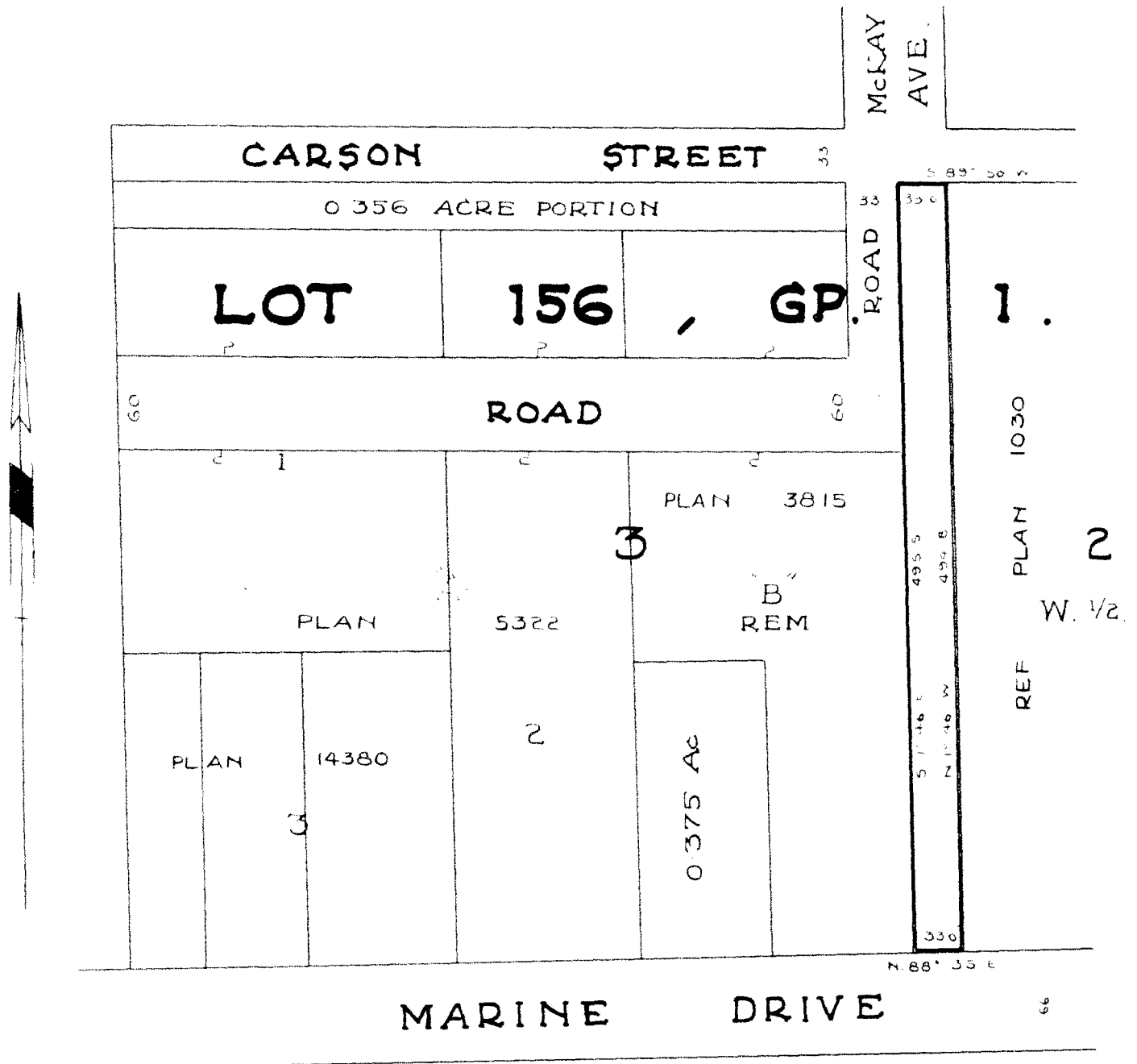
**PLAN OF A PORTION OF

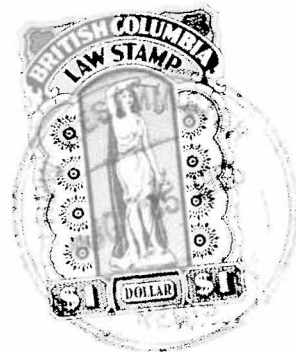
