

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 3642

A BY-LAW to authorize the expenditure of \$34,000.00 out of the special fund set aside under the provisions of Section 537 of the "Municipal Act" for the construction of a municipal fire-hall.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby has by By-law set aside all moneys received from the sale of tax-sale properties.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside are deposited in a special account in The Royal Bank of Canada at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and any interest earned thereon may be used for expenditures of a capital or other special nature.

AND WHEREAS sinking funds on hand are equal to or greater than requirements.

AND WHEREAS the moneys so set aside and interest earned thereon amounted on the Eleventh (11th) day of October, 1955 to Four hundred and twenty-seven thousand, three hundred and sixteen dollars and eighty-five cents (\$427,316.85).

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has purchased the lands hereinafter described from The Director, The Veterans' Land Act, for the sum of Four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00).

AND WHEREAS the said purchase price was advanced out of the Corporation's general fund.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to pay into the Corporation's general fund for such expenditure, the sum of Four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) out of the said special account.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the public interest to erect upon the said lands a Municipal fire-hall according to the plans and specifications prepared by Charles W. Wright, Architect, at an estimated cost of Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) including furnishings and architect's fees.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to expend the sum of Thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000.00) of moneys received from the sale of tax-sale properties and interest thereon and set aside in the special account aforesaid and to pay into the Corporation's general fund the sum of Four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) for the purchase of the lands hereinafter described and to pay out the sum of Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) for the construction and furnishing of a Municipal Fire Hall on those lands purchased as aforesaid, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot Six (6) of Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5) of Block Ten (10), of Lot One hundred and thirty-six (136), Group One (1), New Westminster District, according to Plan 4417 deposited in the Land Registry Office, at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia,

COMMENCING at a point on the Southerly boundary of said Lot Six (6), said point being Seven point zero (7.0) feet South eighty-nine degrees, fifty-six minutes East (S.89°56'E.) from the Southwest corner thereof;

Thence North zero degrees, twenty-seven minutes East (N.0°27'E.) and parallel to the Westerly boundary of said Lot Six (6), One hundred and twenty-five point zero (125.0) feet, more or less, to a point located forty point zero (40.0) feet, South zero degrees, twenty-seven minutes West (S.0°27'W.), from the Northerly boundary thereof;

Thence South eighty-nine degrees, fifty-six minutes East (S.89°56'E.) and parallel to the Northerly boundary of said Lot Six (6), One hundred and forty-six point fifty-three (146.53) feet;

Thence South zero degrees, twenty-seven minutes West (S.0°27'W.) and parallel to the Westerly boundary of said Lot Six (6), One hundred and twenty-five point zero (125.0) feet, more or less, to a point on the Southerly boundary thereof:

Thence North eighty-nine degrees, fifty-six minutes West (N.89°56'W.) and following the Southerly boundary of said Lot Six (6), One hundred and forty-six point fifty-three (146.53) feet to the point of commencement and containing, by estimation, 0.42 of an acre, be the same more or less as more particularly shown outlined with red colour on the plan prepared by Geoffrey K. Burnett, B.C.L.S. and dated the 15th day of September, 1955 and filed in the Land Registry Office, at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.

2. The Reeve and Clerk of the said Corporation are hereby authorized and empowered to do all necessary acts and things to withdraw and expend the said sum of Thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000.00) for the purposes herein specified.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY TAX SALE LANDS MONEYS EXPENDITURE BY-LAW NO. 6, 1955".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council this Fifth (5th) day of December, 1955.

RECEIVED the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council this Thirtieth (30th) day of November, 1955.
